Do you know how many people came to the Crib and Christingle, the Midnight Communion and the Christmas Morning services?

In total, there were 109 children and 225 adults who heard the Good News of Jesus' birth and were encouraged to "Follow the Star". The children were all given a story book as a gift too, donated to the church.



The Christmas Fair raised £1212.81, the church was so full for the school nativities that grown-ups were in the balconies and the 1st Live Nativity was immensely well-supported despite mis-behaving megaphones and donkey (the sheep, Mary and the baby were fabulous though!).

And the Tree Festival just keeps on giving and growing. It's becoming a community-wide event, with new organisations making contact and wanting to join in next year. Some sessions were deserted, some were very busy, but a huge thank you to all who helped, with special mention to Nola.

The Café Christmas Lunch was fully booked and another success, and 9 of us shared a traditional lunch with crackers and nonstop chatter on Christmas Day.

The Social and Fund-raising Committee, the Café teams and the PCC all hope that everyone was able to serve and be served during December in some social way.
